

Seeking

Creative Note: This drama explores the idea of literally seeking God. It also shows the greatness of finding Him and being in His presence.

Characters:

ONE
TWO

(Lights up. TWO, a female, is searching intently around stage. ONE, a male, enters and notices her. He watches for a moment before inquiring of her. During their conversation TWO is constantly looking and searching.)

ONE: What are you doing?

TWO: Seeking.

ONE: Seeking?

TWO: Yes.

ONE: What?

TWO: "To look for or try to find."

ONE: Huh?

TWO: That is the definition of "seek."

ONE: No. I know that.

TWO: Then why did you ask?

ONE: I didn't.

TWO: Yes you did. You asked what I was doing. I said I was seeking. You said, "seeking?" I said, "yes." You said, "what?" And I answered what seeking is.

ONE: I meant what are you seeking.

TWO: What am I seeking?

ONE: Yes. As you've pointed out seeking means to look for or try to find. So, what are you looking for or trying to find.

TWO: Oh. Right. What is the object of my seeking?

ONE: Exactly.

TWO: God.

ONE: God?

TWO: Yeah.

ONE: You are physically, actually seeking . . . God.

TWO: That's right.

ONE: Why?

TWO: What do you mean "why?" Isn't it obvious?

ONE: If it were would I really be asking?

TWO: Well . . . because I'm supposed to.

ONE: How do you know?

TWO: Let's see . . . 1 Kings 22:5, "first seek the counsel of the Lord." 1 Chronicles 16:11, "seek his face always." Psalm 34:10, "those who seek the Lord lack no good thing." Amos 5:6, "seek the Lord and live." Matthew 6:33, "seek first his kingdom and his righteousness."

ONE: OK. OK. I get it. But I've got one too.

TWO: Really?

ONE: Oh yeah. Check this out. Isaiah 55:6, "seek the Lord while he may be found."

TWO: What's your point?

ONE: "While he may be found." What if He can't be found anymore?

TWO: Huh?

ONE: What if that time has come and gone?
What if you're just seeking in vain? What
if you never find Him?

TWO: But I will.

ONE: How do you know?

TWO: I just do.

ONE: How can you be sure?

TWO: (*sighs*) Proverbs 8:17, "those who seek
me find me." Matthew 7:7, "seek and you
will find."

ONE: Hmm. Interesting . . . Let me ask you this.

TWO: What?

ONE: You are seeking God, right?

TWO: Right?

ONE: And "to seek," means to look for or try to
find?

TWO: Yeah. We've already covered this.

ONE: Okay. And that's what you've been
doing? This whole time? Looking for
God? Trying to find Him?

TWO: Yeah.

ONE: And you're convinced that you will find
Him?

TWO: Absolutely.

ONE: How will you know when you've found
Him?

TWO: What do you mean?

ONE: I mean He's God. How will you know God
when you find Him?

TWO: That's how.

ONE: What's how?

TWO: What you just said.

ONE: What did I say?

TWO: He's God.

ONE: So?

TWO: So He's not like anything or anyone else.
That's how I'll know. He'll be God. Just
like He's said.

ONE: Yeah . . . but . . .

TWO: (*looking somewhere new*) Shh! I think I'm
on to something.
