

ROOM SET-UP

Divide the room into two sections. Put a piece of masking tape on the floor straight down the center of the room to divide it in half. On one side, put broken, rusty objects, such as old pots and pans or an old rusty rake. They should be tarnished and decaying. On that side, take out some of the lights and move some of the chairs out of row. If you have drop ceilings, take some tiles out and turn others crooked. On the other half, put all new things. Try to have a brand new equivalent of each old, rusty thing that you use on the other side. Use this to start discussions on restoration.
